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

In December 2017, we projected that China's softwood log+lumber imports (RWE) would be stable in 2018








Problems with the trade data

- Gap in Chinese reporting of trade data starting in April
- Shift to weight-only reporting for log and lumber imports
- Problem with weight to volume conversion factors
- Issues not only with trade data



Official statistics on Russia's softwood timber harvest are simply estimated from total harvest levels


Share of Softwood in Russian Timber Harvest Statistics





Using official Russian data for softwood timber harvests leads to overly optimistic forecasts of future trends


Reported Russian Softwood Timber Harvest





The good news: our forecast for 2018 total softwood imports in China was very close


China: Imports of Softwood Logs and Lumber (RWE)





The bad news: we missed the shift back towards more logs, less lumber


China: Softwood Log and Lumber Imports, Jan-Nov





New Zealand's log market share in China increased to 40% in 2018E, and Uruguay also ramped up quickly


China Softwood Log Imports





Chinese imports of Russian softwood logs and lumber were 10% lumber in 2007, but were an estimated 76% in 2018


Chinese Imports of Softwood from Russia






But Russia's total softwood log + lumber (RWE) exports are still below 2007 peak

Russia's Total Softwood Log and Lumber Exports






Unprocessed logs were 61% of Russia's wood products export value in 2001, but only 16% in 2018E






Exports of pine logs from the US South to China have reduced by 60% from their peak earlier in 2018





Incredibly, over 40% of US softwood log exports to China in 2018 have been from the South, in containers

Share of US Softwood Log Exports to China From US South



Log shipments from the PNW to China have also declined


USA Softwood Log Exports to China





While the South has gained ground, the PNW is still by far the largest source of log exports


US Softwood Log Exports to Asia, PNW and South





Russia has become the dominant softwood lumber supplier to China; the USA is a minor player


China Softwood Lumber Imports, Jan-Nov 2018





In 2018, the biggest jump in US softwood lumber exports was to the Caribbean

US softwood lumber exports to China did include a strong share of treated product, but that market has tanked








64% of lumber exports were to North American and Caribbean countries in 2018; only 5% went to Japan, vs. 21% in 2000


US Softwood Lumber Exports by Destination, 2018





Japanese softwood lumber imports have been in a long, slowly declining trend for the past 20 years


Japan: Softwood Lumber Imports





We focus so much energy on China, but Mexico has been a more stable market and is just as large


US Softwood Lumber Exports to China and Mexico





In the near term, US lumber exports will fall due to relatively strong domestic markets

The share of Canadian softwood lumber exported to Asia peaked at 34% in 2011, now 21%

Canada: Softwood Lumber Exports to Asia






Canadian lumber exports to the USA will remain relatively stable, but exports to Asia will continue to fall
